MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

RARA will be run by a management committee ("Committee") elected at the Annual General Meeting. The Committee will be made up of Officers, including a Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and ordinary members.

Members wishing to serve on the committee must stand at AGM and be endorsed by at least two other members.

Committee officers will be appointed by the Committee. All matters for decision will be decided by a simple majority of those present and voting.

The Committee will provide an update to the residents of the area at least twice a year on their work. This could be in the form of meetings, newsletters or website updates.

There will be a minimum of 4 Committee meetings held during the course of a year (including the Annual General Meeting).

Seven days' notice of committee meetings will be given to all members of the Committee.

The quorum for Committee meetings shall be a minimum of 4 members.

Where a casual vacancy (or vacancies) arises on the Committee, it/they will be filled by election at the next General Meeting of RARA.

The Committee shall deal with any issues of management of RARA which require decision during the periods between General Meetings of RARA, and report these to the next Annual General Meeting.

Committee members who miss more than three consecutive meetings without giving reasonable apologies will be asked to resign their post. A member of the Committee may be removed or suspended from their post if they bring the good name of RARA into disrepute. A full meeting of the Committee will be called to consider evidence from all sides and a majority vote will be necessary to remove or suspend.
